LOCAL GARDENER INDUCTED TO BRAMLICH COLLEGE ATHLETIC HALL OF FAME

BRAMLICH, Minn. (Sept. 23, 2019) — Colleen Dubay, a life-long resident of Pittsburgh known for her award-winning garden will be inducted to the Athletic Hall of Fame at Bramlich College.

Dubay, 50, grew up in the Franklin Park area of Pittsburgh and graduated from Bramlich College in Minnesota in 1986. Dubay was a member of the college's women's gymnastics team for all four years she attended Bramlich. In 1986, her senior year, Dubay won the NCAA Division II women's gymnastics championship.

"My athletic days are long behind me, but I still remember my time at Bramlich College fondly," Dubay said.

Dubay is one of four alumni who will be awarded for their performance in intercollegiate sports at Bramlich College. At the Oct. 12 ceremony, inductees will receive certificates from Marcus Irvin, the president of the Bramlich College Alumni Club, and their photos will be added to the Bramlich College Field House Honor Wall.
