Ravelry is a user-driven website developed to centralize online knitting, crocheting, weaving, spinning and dyeing communities. It allows pattern designers to sell their patterns on-site and allows all users to organize information about their patterns, projects, tools and yarn. Ravelry aims to cultivate an inclusive and supportive community of creators.

Vendor areas are open to attendees 6:30 - 9 p.m. Friday; 8 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. Saturday; and 8 a.m. - 2 p.m. Sunday. Vendors will be allowed in one hour before and after these times to set up and take down their booths. Your vendor badge is your pass to get in to the vendor areas outside of open hours.

Vendors 1-49 are in Room H.  
Vendors 50-99 are in Room G.  
Vendors 100-125 are in the main hallway.

One booth in each vendor areas is a Vendor Assistant Station. Vendor Assistants are available to help set up your booths and watch your booth if you need a short break, but can not make sales.
